



#### HISTORY

- 1995 created as a K-12 network by ISBE
- 1999 20 ILCS 3921 created the ICN
- 2004 ICN consolidated into CMS
- 2005 state agency network migrated to ICN
- 2010 awarded \$96M in federal stimulus & state capital funds to build fiber backbone
- 2014 fiber backbone completed
- 2019 awarded \$20M for upgrades and K-12 connectivity



## DolT K-12 CONSORTIUM - JOINING

- Receive Internet access via the ICN, and receive ICN services
  - Can connect to the ICN via your own circuit or have the consortium procure the circuit
- Consortium can also procure your WAN circuits.
- Document available that describes the ICN services, and provides step by step guidance on E-rate Form 470 to procure your own circuit to the ICN

#### **ICN** Services

 Requires a connection to the ICN, a point to point connection from your head end location to the ICN

## Why procure circuits via the consortium?

- The awarded vendor may be the same as your current vendor
- You can pick and choose the consortium circuits to move forward with for example, you may choose just the last mile circuit to the ICN
- Allows to compare pricing
- You're not obligated to move forward with the consortium
